Prof Manuel Katz is an Israeli, Argentinean born Pediatrician married to Ana, has 3 children and 8 grandchildren. During his almost 50 years in practice was active as senior Pediatrician in hospital and community settings, docent in Pediatrics, with management positions as Deputy General Director at a tertiary care hospital and Medical Director in a HMO in Israel. Was for 8 years Director of Maternal and Child Health Department at the Southern area on Israel. Dr Katz has an Academic fellowship in Health Policy and Management at Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, USA

His current position is Director of Risk Management and Patient Safety at Meuhedet Health Services. Dr Katz is Professor in Pediatrics at Maimonides University (Argentina), NIMS university , india and (Ret Docent) at Ben Gurion University (Israel), From 2016 is President of "GOSHEN" foundation, dedicated to creating a holistic community healthcare environment in a pioneering approach to 21st century early child development. From the last 25 years is chairing the Israel Steering Committee on Domestic Violence, sexual abuse and helpless populations, and is member of the National Council for Pediatrics and Child health of the Israel Ministry of Health
