



Prof Daniele Trevisanuto

Daniele Trevisanuto is Associate Professor at the University of Padova, Italy, past-president of the Veneto Region Italian Society of Neonatology and Director of the East Veneto Region Neonatal Transport Service. Professor Trevisanuto is the director of the joint master on “Pediatric and neonatal emergencies” between the University of Padua (Italy), University Eduardo Mondlane and Catholic University of Mozambique (Mozambique). From 2012 to 2015 he was the Secretary of the Study Group on Neonatal Resuscitation, Italian Society of Neonatology.

He is a member of the International Liaison Committee on Resuscitation– Neonatal Resuscitation Task Force and a member of the Neonatal Life Support Task Force-European Resuscitation Council.

His research focuses on neonatal resuscitation, education, maternal and neonatal care in low-resource countries, neonatal airway management, neonatal transport.

He is author or co-author of about 320 peer-reviewed articles (PubMed) and has published 6 chapters in neonatology books. He is the co-inventor of a supraglottic airway device for drug delivery.
